## How To Use This:

Parents of children Grades 1-6:

1. If you have young children in this age bracket, you should start by doing this with them for a few weeks. You will notice that the items are not specific to weekly work assigned. This is on purpose, and is intended to begin the process of learning self-evaluation. Encourage your kids to be honest with themselves.
2. Be sure you have a clear understanding of what they are supposed to do, particularly if the teacher overrides your average on the low side (the teacher can go either way). Check the Homework emails for your daily minute goal for practicing.
3. If you don't show an interest, why should they?
4. By the time they are at the end of Grade 2, you should only need to check this on Saturday nights (so you can rescue the weekend practice if it isn't happening!).

Students in Grade 7-12:

1. You should be doing this on your own by now.
2. Be honest with yourself. It doesn't take a lot of effort to get better, what it takes is *consistency*, and doing it each day listed below. You can be a leader and get excellent grades in music by just trying a little bit each day.
